Global Renewable Energy Infrastructure Investor, New Energy Solar, appoints John Martin as Chief Executive Officer

New Energy Solar (**NES**) today announced that it has appointed John Martin as Chief Executive Officer (**CEO**). John is a leading expert in the infrastructure and energy sectors, having held senior roles in banking and corporate advisory in the infrastructure and utilities sectors over the past two decades.

The US solar power projects comprise total capacity of 226.2MW, with all plants on stream and providing emissions-free power under long term power purchase agreements to large-scale energy consumers and utilities.

John Martin said, "I am very excited to be assuming the role of CEO at New Energy Solar. The pace of change in the renewable energy market is accelerating, and NES is well-placed to capitalise on the growing efficiency and relative cost advantage of renewable power generation."

Large corporations are seeking and investing in alternate power sources to reduce energy costs and meet their social impact goals, and I am looking forward to growing NES' investments in the underlying infrastructure of this new energy market." concluded Mr Martin.
